SUMMARY

An Australian tech company that develops recruitment software and has a 20-year-old brand name wanted to re-engineer its product for an updated technology stack.

After Microsoft announced that Silverlight would no longer be supported, the company looked for a software partner to help them update their product to the newest technology using the Dot Net Framework.



PROBLEM STATEMENT

- ❗ The current code was not scalable.
- ❗ Due to the old technology of the application, they were losing on new businesses.
- ❗ Lack of latest technology knowledge on the floor and learning was time-consuming and not cost-effective

SOLUTION



A modern, safe, and scalable architecture using .NET core, angular, SQL Server, and Bootstrap was designed in-house by technical experts.



Developers from the client side were provided training sessions so they could perform parallel development as well.



A specific software application was created to enable the upgrade of the existing software. Other databases could be migrated with minimal configuration using this migration tool.



We developed brand-new, secure APIs that allow them to integrate their products with any other product, further expanding the application's capability.
